Ashton Bears have enjoyed success across multiple competitions, particularly within regional leagues such as the North West Counties Rugby League.

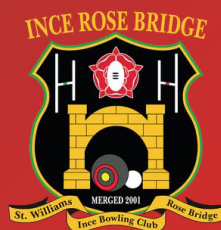

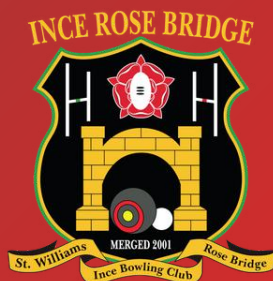

REIGNITING RIVALRIES

While both clubs are now locked in the NCL North West Conference, their journeys to the top of the amateur game followed two very different paths.

The Standard Bearers: Ince Rose Bridge

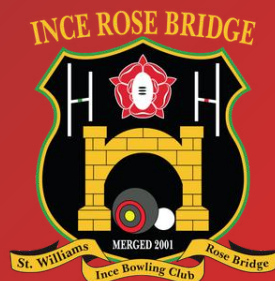
Since the mid-1980s, Pinfold Street has been a fortress of the National Conference League. The "Bridge" is the traditional powerhouse of the area, known for a rugged, physical style of play that has acted as a production line for professional talent for decades.

- The Glory Days: Supporters still talk about the 1982–83 season, when the club captured its first BARLA Lancashire Cup with a dominant 25–5 win over Crosfields. They repeated the feat in 2001, cementing their status as amateur royalty.

The Modern Powerhouse: Ashton Bears

If the Bridge is the "Old Guard," the Bears are the modern expansionists. Originally a dominant force in the North West Men's League (NWML), their rise has been fueled by a massive junior network and a "never-say-die" expansive playing style.

- The Turning Point: The 2007–08 Lancashire Cup Final was the moment the Bears truly arrived. Though they didn't take the trophy that day, it signaled their transition from a regional side to a national threat.

Key Scoring Highlights:

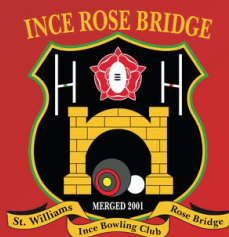
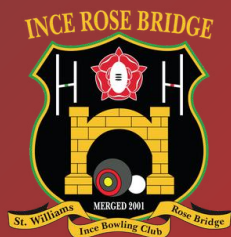
- Alex Crompton, a recent signing from Wigan St. Pats, made an immediate impact by crossing for our first try on his debut.

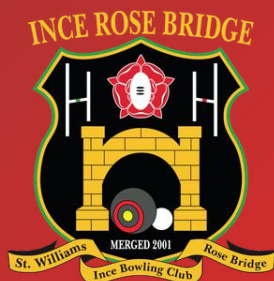
Friday Night Lights: 1st Team vs. Ashton
